In addition, it is important to be able to prove one's identity in the form of:          - asylum seeker travel document;          - special passport for foreigners;          - another identity document.</p>
<p><b>Students with inclusion support</b></p>	<p>Students with special needs whose physical, mental or health-related condition is such that their participation in the project/mobility activity would not be possible without extra financial or additional support</p>	<p>Certificate issued by a general practitioner or a specialist doctor (the original document is requested, not older than 6 months) and the decision of the competent institution/state body showing the percentage and type of disability (copy, if applicable).</p>
